Terry was born in Toronto and grew up in Mississauga, Ontario. He later attended The University of Ottawa and completed an honours degree in music, focusing mostly on composition and classical guitar.

Now based in Ottawa, Terry is back with his sixth recording. In 2010 he shifted from writing folk/rock, singer-songwriter tunes to writing instrumental, guitar-based, smooth jazz. This new project bridges the gap between his last two guitar offerings, "Shh" and "The Sand in My Shoes". Combining elements of jazz and Latin music, he now presents five engaging and dynamic tracks on, "Blue. Green. Aquamarine." The title refers to the blend of musical colours on the project.



A special highlight on the EP is the presence of Canadian jazz piano legend, Brian Browne, who plays on the final track. It also hosts a stellar group of Ottawa musicians including producer/drummer Ross Murray, bassist Stu Watkins (formerly of The Tenors), and many others.

His last project, "The Sand In My Shoes" received positive press in Exclaim!, Cashbox Canada, The Daily Vault and The Smooth Jazz Ride. Terry's music has received extensive airplay across Canada on many CBC stations and is in continued rotation on Stingray Radio, The Jewel and other community stations in Ontario. He has been featured in CBC's Music Matters and has been interviewed many times on radio stations in the Ottawa area.
